FAST Act, the Fixing America’s Surface Transportation Act, was signed into law by President Obama on December 4, 2015. FAST Act was the first law enacted in over ten years that provides long-term funding certainty for surface transportation. The act continues the requirement that Metropolitan Planning Organizations prepare an annual listing of projects, including investments in pedestrian walkways and bicycle transportation facilities, for which Federal funds have been obligated in the preceding year under 23 U.S.C or 49 U.S.C. Chapter 53. The listing shall be published no later than 90 calendar days following the end of the program year and made available by the cooperative effort of the state, transit operator and metropolitan planning organization for public review. The following tables and maps provide information on transportation projects located in the Kentucky portion of the OKI region that were obligated for spending using federal funds during federal fiscal year 2020—October 1, 2019 through September 30, 2020. Ohio and Indiana projects have been listed in a separate report covering state fiscal year 2020—July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2020.

The OKI region includes Butler, Clermont, Hamilton and Warren counties in Ohio; Boone, Campbell and Kenton counties in Kentucky; and, Dearborn County in Indiana. Maps are provided in this report for highway projects that have funds for any phase authorized in fiscal year 2020. Some of these projects may have been awarded in previous fiscal years and had federal funds authorized prior to fiscal year 2020.

The information provided here is consistent with how projects are listed in the OKI TIP, i.e. projects are shown with a project identification number, route, section, location and description of project and funding amounts. This list provides information on the amount of funds programmed in the TIP, the amount of federal funds that were authorized during fiscal year 2020 and the amount of funds remaining and available for use in subsequent years. Projects are listed by county, map identification number and KYTC item number. The project type refers to the primary purpose of the project. Some projects not specifically identified as “bicycle/pedestrian” may contain a bicycle or pedestrian component.

Project obligation information is also provided for one federally funded transit operator in the Kentucky portion of the region—the Transit Authority of Northern Kentucky (TANK) during federal fiscal year 2020.

An obligation is the federal government’s legal commitment to pay the federal share of a project’s cost. An obligated project is one that has been authorized by a federal agency, such as the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) or the Federal Transit Administration (FTA). Obligated projects are not necessarily initiated or completed in the programmed year and the amount of the obligation may not necessarily equal the total cost of the project. For FTA projects, obligation occurs when the FTA grant is awarded. For FHWA projects, the obligation occurs when a project agreement is executed and the state/grantee requests that the funds be obligated.

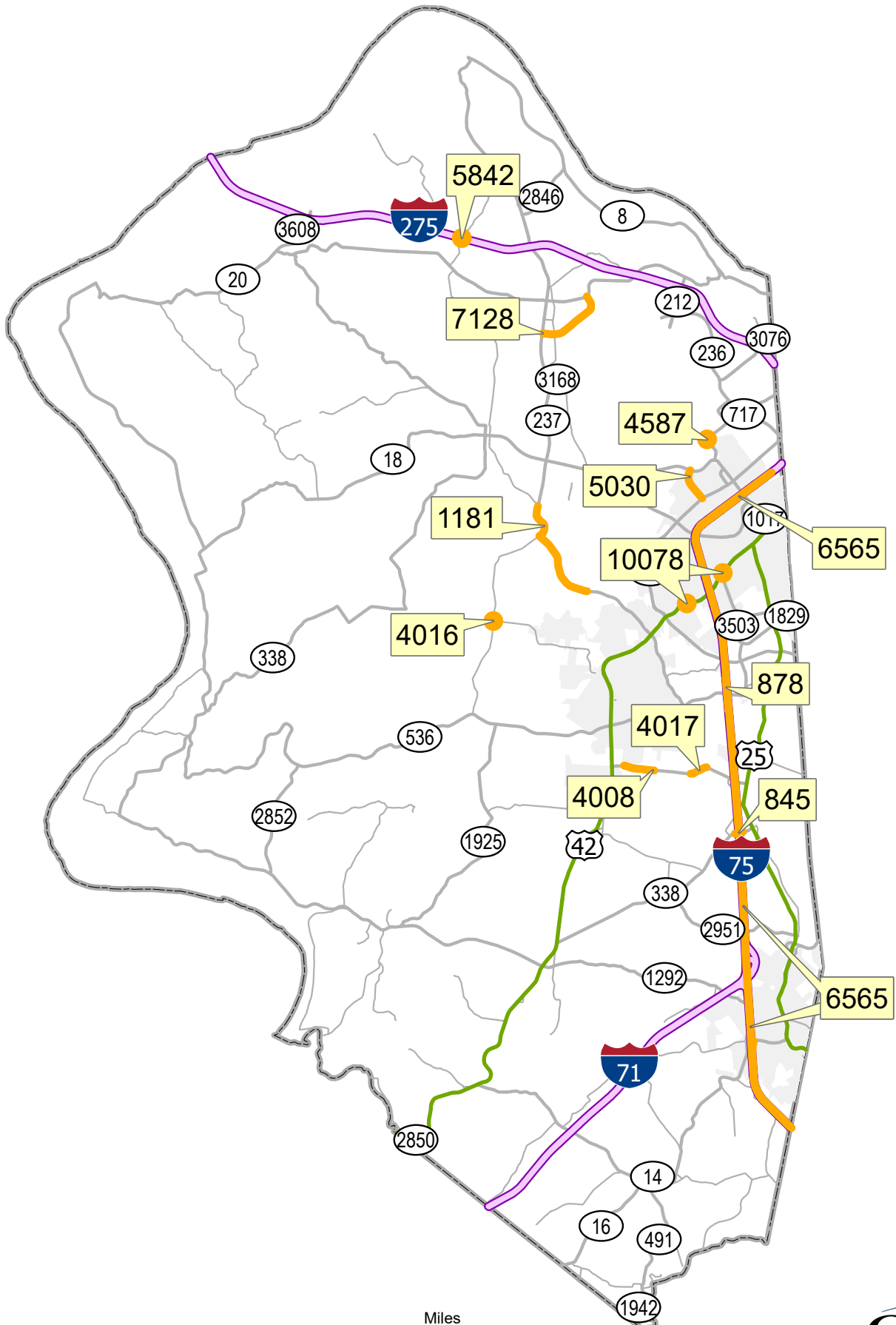

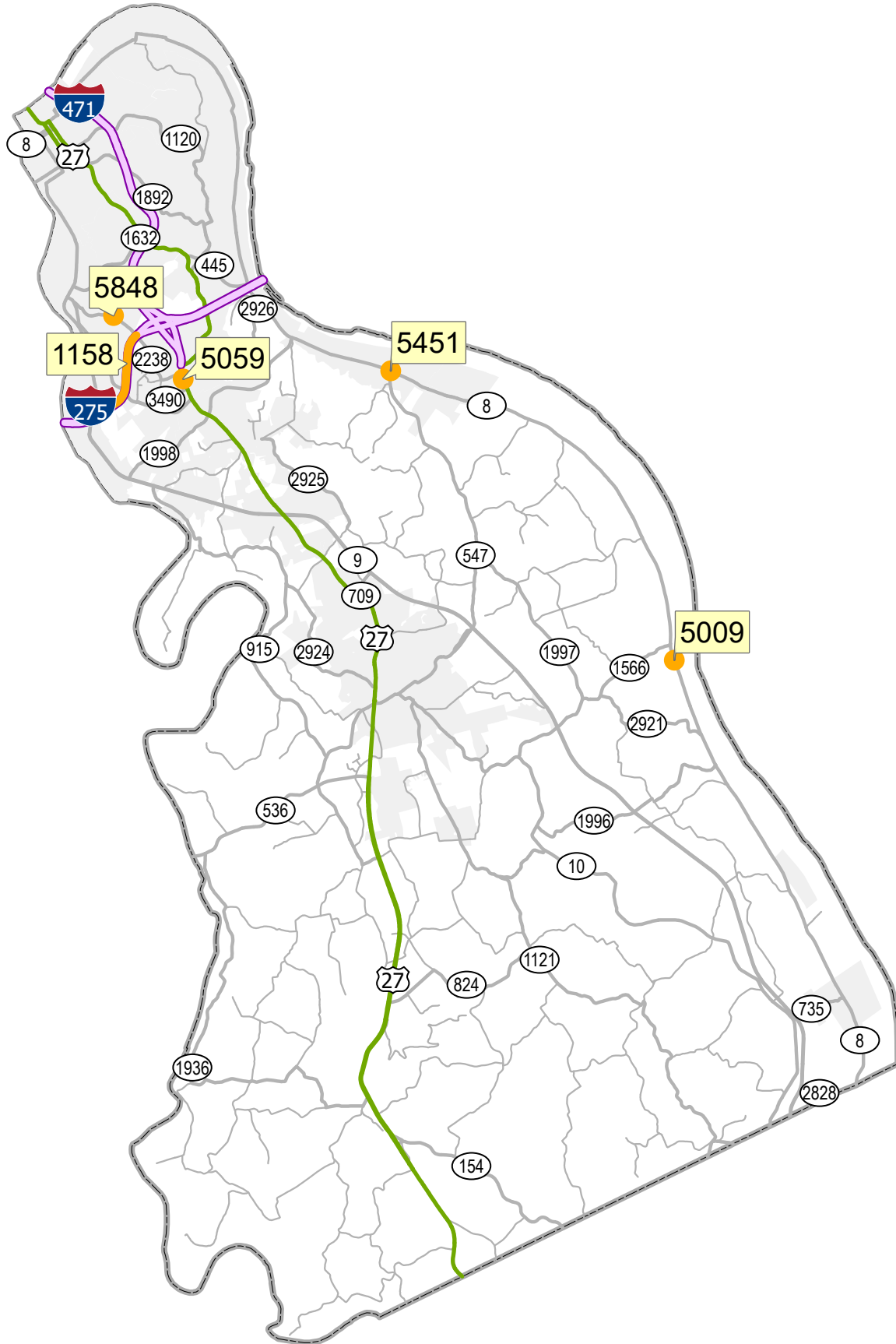
Fiscal Year 2020 Obligated Highway Projects

Boone County, KY



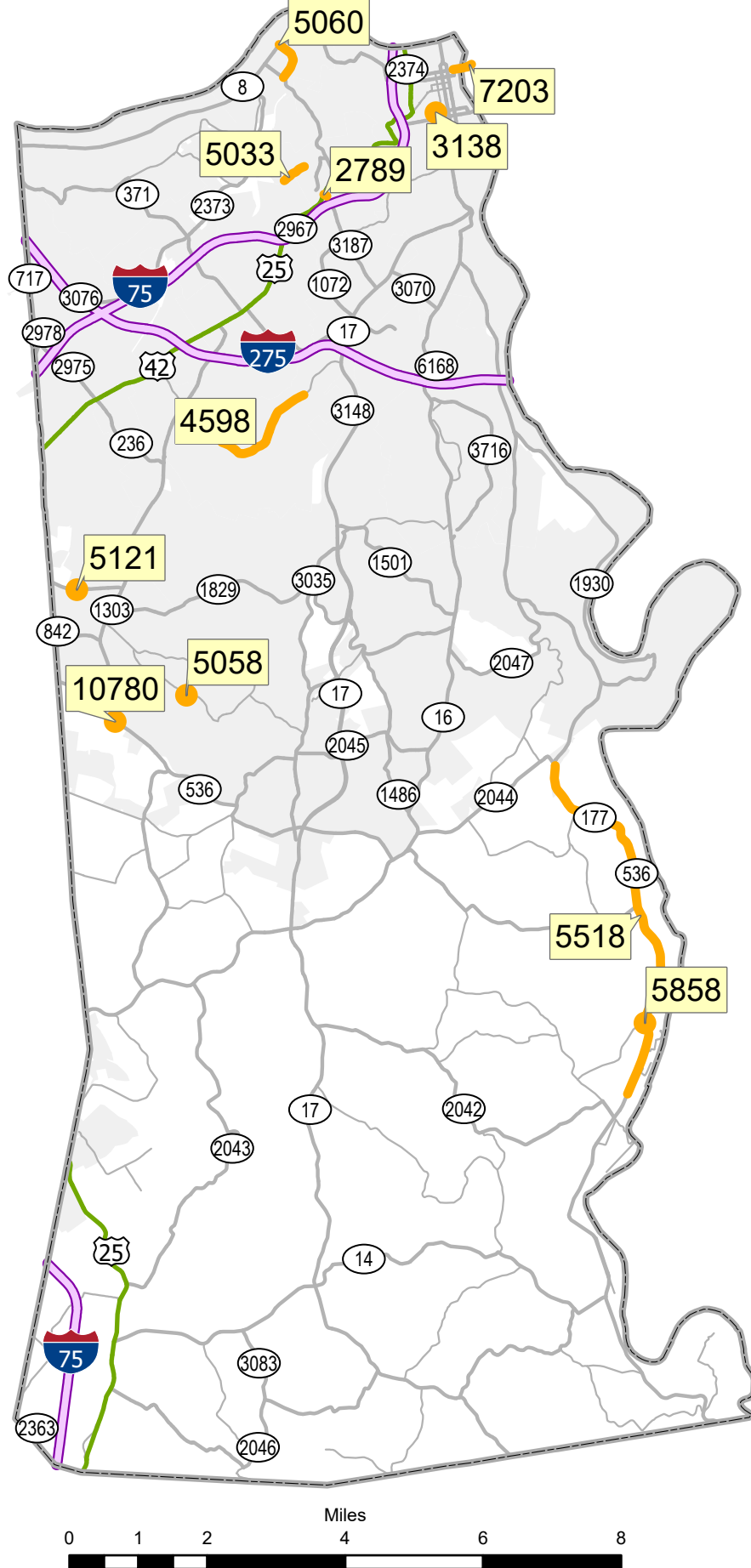
Fiscal Year 2020 Obligated Highway Projects

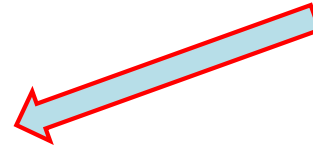
